OKAPI's setting named "SITE_URL" should contain the preferred scheme/protocol in which you want developers to access your site. https://github.com/opencaching/okapi/blob/3b7a5b1afabf4c853df558934388a5fc9ba6bb08/okapi/settings.php#L136 However, I think that currently your value of SITE_URL is determined dynamically, based on the protocol used during the request. This seems wrong. Shouldn't you just set "SITE_URL" to "https://www.opencaching.de/"?
